1 **WHEREAS**, the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) Football
2 Federation Women's Championship, established in 2004, is a prestigious international
3 competition in women's football organized by the ASEAN Football Federation (AFF), and
4 participated in by the national teams of nations in Southeast Asia and Australia;

5 **WHEREAS**, the 2022 AFF Women's Football Championship was held at the Rizal
6 Memorial Sports Complex, Manila on July 4 to July 17, 2022, and participated in by 11
7 nations, including Indonesia, Malaysia, Singapore, Myanmar, Timor-Leste, Cambodia,
8 Laos, Philippines, Australia, the four-time AFF Women's championship title holder
9 Thailand, and 31st SEA Games gold medalist Vietnam;

10 **WHEREAS**, the Philippine Women's National Football team, also known as
11 "Filipinas", was grouped alongside Indonesia, Singapore, Australia, Malaysia, and
12 Thailand;

1 **WHEREAS**, in a historic first, the Philippine Women’s National Football team won
2 the AFF Women’s Championship title against four-time champion titleholder Thailand,
3 and earned their first-ever major international trophy;

4 **WHEREAS**, team Filipinas decisive victory of 3-0 marked the country’s first
5 international title at the AFF Women’s Football category, and has qualified the team to
6 participate for the 2023 *Federation Internationale de Football Association* World Cup;

7 **WHEREAS**, the Philippine Women’s National Football team who won the 2022 AFF
8 Women’s Championship is composed of 27 players, namely: Inna Palacios, Olivia McDaniel,
9 Kiara Fontanilla, Malea Cesar, Dominique Randle, Hali Long, Chantelle Maniti, Sofia
10 Harrison, Eva Madarang, Tara Shelton, Maya Alcantara, Jaclyn Sawicki, Tahnai Annis,
11 Camille Rodriguez, Jessica Miclat, Ryley Bugay, Anika Castañeda, Kaya Hawkinson, Quinley
12 Quezada, Katrina Guillou, Sara Eggesvik, Jessika Cowart, Sarina Bolden, Isabella Flanigan,
13 Carleigh Frilles, Alisha Del Campo, and Alyssa Ube;

14 **WHEREAS**, as the country recognizes the historic win of the members of the Filipinas
15 team who brought pride and honor to the country, the Filipino people likewise acknowledge
16 and commend the vital role, unwavering support, and able mentorship of the officials of the
17 Philippine Football Federation led by its President Mariano Araneta, Jr., and the coaching and
18 management staff of the Philippine Women’s National Football team composed of the
19 following: Alen Stajcic, Jefferson Cheng, Nahuel Arrarte, Marnelli Dimzon, Rachelle Delos
20 Reyes, Jimmy Fraser, Luca Tonetti, Stevan Antonic, Anna Liza Demegillo, Vanessa Castelo,
21 Red Sajonia, Neille Anne Casalmer, Isabella Fernando, Francisco Pascual, and Miriam
22 Gonzaga;

23 **WHEREAS**, the members of the Filipinas team serve as a beacon of women
24 empowerment in their triumph over the many challenges as they relentlessly pursued their
25 dreams and aspirations not only for themselves but for the country as well, demonstrating the
26 vital role of women in sports;

27 **WHEREAS**, the Philippine Women’s National Football team deserves to be
28 congratulated and commended by the Filipino people for establishing the country’s status as
29 the best in the Southeast Asian region in the light of its historic win at the AFF Women’s
30 Championship thus earning the right to be called the ‘Queens of Southeast Asian Football’:
